

## **Schedule of Fees**(Annex 2 to the General Terms and Conditions of Business - Biomethane)

Version 1.1. valid as of 11 September 2012

1. The Biomethane Registry Austria charges account holders the annual fees below for the provision of the registry and for the use of the registry per calendar year; the fees are due in advance for the current calendar year and must be paid to the registry operator:

Annual fee for registry account holders<sup>1,2</sup> EUR 2,000 p.a. per registry account<sup>1,2</sup>

- Biomethane plant operators, biomethane electrification plant operators and technical experts ("auditors") in the meaning of § 21 (1) Green Electricity Act 2012, Federal Law Gazette I 75/2011, are exempt from the duty to pay this fee.
- **2.** Fees already paid are not refunded applies also to partial refunds on the grounds of termination of the contract between the registry operator and an account holder.
- **3.** The provisions of § 9 (1) (2), § 10 (1) (2) and § 12 of the E-Commerce Act, Federal Law Gazette I 152/2001 do not apply to relations between the registry operator and the registry account holders, provided the latter are not consumers in the meaning of the Consumer Protection Act.

This Schedule of Fees, version 1.1, is part of the General Terms and Conditions of Business for the Use of the Biomethane Registry Austria (Biomethane T&C) and takes effect on 11 September 2012. The Schedule of Fees, version 1.0, no longer applies as of this date.

The fee includes all statutory charges, but excludes value added tax. It is due annually in a single payment within 14 days of the day the invoice was issued by the registry operator and must be paid to the registry operator. The full amount of the fee is due for intra-year periods from the time the application to open a registry account is submitted until the close of the calendar year of application.
